--Highest scoring workshops have a "take away" --Think what you can create to allow a colleague to introduce/implement your workshop topic into their own program

--Toolkit, new eval form, curriculum outline

Perseverance

--Many factors go into workshop selection including overall score,
diverse representation of programs/speakers, appropriate mix of topics
--Bottom line: Don't be afraid to re-submit!
--Your workshop may be a better fit for a different meeting
--Keep workshop submissions in a word document for easy copy/paste
into next meeting's submission form!
